#### THE CHALLENGE

Africa has the highest number of female entrepreneurs in the world and women run over quarter of all businesses on the African continent, yet they still struggle to raise adequate funding to scale their businesses to the levels of their male counterparts. Representation, funding, and access market opportunities remain the key factors impeding diversity across various sectors of our economies



#### THE RESPONSE

In response to these challenges DLO launched the Women in Leadership Summit in 2023 which gathered board members, CEOs, entrepreneurs, creatives, political leadership, and civil society, with the objective of driving meaningful changes towards the representation of women across all sectors of the economy.

Over the past 2 years the Summit has provided a space for women and men to think critically around issues of inclusion. In 2023 we partnered with KPMG to produce a report to highlight how boards were





# WHAT WE CAN EXPECT FROM THE SUMMIT IN 2025

Over the past 2 years we have devolved in deep critical thinking around leadership and representation across boards and key leadership positions in organizations and across various critical sectors. This year our theme is "time for tangible action" and the summit will examine critical areas around:

- 1. Funding products and their accessibility to women led enterprises.
- 2. The culture of sponsorship as opposed to mentorship in accelerating access to business opportunities for women
- 3. 1. Opportunities in new industries such as technology where women stand to benefit.

We will still explore themes around representation across the various sectors with an underlying focus on the on the enabling policies, environments and structures. In this year's Summit the focus will be on implementation and taking the next tangible steps toward meaningful reforms.

The theme for this year's Summit is "Can an Al Driven Future Make Space for Women in Leadership? Al has the potential to positively impact gender dynamics in organizations through:

- Reducing bias in recruitment
- Promoting data driven decisions
- Given women work and home life balance through flexible work arrangements

However, realizing these benefits requires careful design and implementation of AI systems to avoid perpetuating existing biases or creating new ones. This year the DLO African women in Leadership Summit will explore the various ways in which AI and diversity intersect and explore what this means for women in leadership.
